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GASPOOL revises gas quality switchover charge up to 0,0865 €/kWh/h/a

Berlin (Germany). The pass-through amount charged at all exit points within the GASPOOL market area to recover the costs for switching over network areas from low CV gas quality to high CV quality valid from 1 January 2016 had to be corrected due to errors in the underlying capacity data reported to the company. At the beginning of this week GASPOOL was notified that one transmission system operator (TSO) had submitted incorrect data, as a consequence of which the pass-through amount had to be recalculated. The correct charge is 0,0865 €/kWh/h/a.

The German federal regulator Bundesnetzagentur has been informed about these subsequent corrections for the calendar year 2016.
